

## Rome

### Campion Platt

#### RESTAURANTS

Casina Valadier on the Pincio Hill, with Rome spread out below, is delicious and visually more than satisfying. Also great is Caffè Greco, a famous late-18th-century café near the Hotel d' Inghilterra.

#### HOTELS

**Hassler Roma:** An example of refined elegance.

#### SHOPPING

**Bonora:** A famous cobbler with a range of off-the-shelf and custom-made shoes. For furniture, both classical and Modern, I like **Spazio Sette**. It's located in a 17th-century palazzo, and its ceiling frescoes, all original, are magical.

#### **LEISURE**

I like to get **ice cream at the side of the Pantheon** and eat it on the fountain steps—in front of one of the most perfect buildings in the world.

#### **OUTDOORS**

Palatine Hill: It doesn't matter where you go on the hill; the views of the ancient Flavian Palace are superb.

#### **TRADITION**

Marino Grape Festival: Wine—gods desired it, and royalty took great pleasure in it. After the festival, I return to central Rome and wander to Piazza Navona for coffee and a moment of artistic admiration in front of the Bernini fountain.

### Alexander Gorlin

#### **RESTAURANTS**

**Taverna Giulia** has the best pesto in the world.

#### HOTELS

The favorite of 19th-century Russian dignitaries, the **Hotel de Russie**, now renovated, is a fantastic combination of old and new, with an extensive and beautiful garden.

#### SHOPPING

**La Bottega del Marmoraro:** A wonderful, quirky collection of inscribed marble plaques and objects, run by a father and son.

#### **LEISURE**

The park on **Janiculum Hill**, where you can see the entire city nestled among the seven hills.

#### **OUTDOORS**

**Piazza della Rotunda:** Incomparable piazza in front of the monumental portico and dome of the Pantheon built by Hadrian in 118–128.

#### **TRADITION**

It's been a tradition to post a satirical message, political or personal, on the *Pasquino*, an ancient Roman statue that's located in Piazza Pasquino, near Piazza Navona. There must be many notes about Berlusconi these days!

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
